

WHITE WINE

- 1. Stoney Vale “Colombard/Chardonnay”, 2004 - Australia** **£10.95**
This classic Aussie blend reveals notes of citrus and melon fruit leading to a dry, fresh tropical fruit palate.
- 2. Lutzville Cape Diamond “Chenin Blanc”, 2005 - South Africa** **£11.95**
A luscious straw gold wine with a hint of guava and the delicious richness of dried fruit on the tongue.
- 3. Waterstone Bridge “Reserve Chardonnay”, 2003 - Australia** **£13.50**
This Chardonnay has been crafted from a blend of premium vineyards and shows crisp flavours of pineapple and tropical fruit, blended in harmony to create a refreshing smooth wine.
- 4. Anakena Chardonnay Reserve, 2004 – Chile** **£14.95**
Pale golden straw in colour, this Chardonnay Reserve is bursting with tropical fruit, citrus, floral aromas. A delicate balance of fresh fruit and light oak, combine to produce a rounded and complex wine with a long refreshing finish.
- 5. Culley “Sauvignon Blanc”, 2004 - New Zealand** **£16.95**
A vibrant wine with attractive tropical flavours balanced with crisp acidity and a lingering finish.
- 6. Hope Estate “Chardonnay” 2002 – Australia (Hunter Valley)** **£18.95**
Peach, figs and tropical fruit on the nose are balanced with fresh citrus and melon on the palate. The fruit integrates with the creamy oak flavours to achieve a complex and full mouthfeel with persistent flavours and a crisp, refreshing finish.

RED WINE

- 7. Stoney Vale Cabernet/Shiraz, 2004 - Australia** **£10.95**
This Cabernet Shiraz blend is full flavoured and smooth with soft, ripe blackcurrant and bramble fruit.
- 8. Lutzville Cape Diamond Pinotage, 2004 - South Africa** **£11.95**
Unique to South Africa, this light ruby coloured wine has a pleasant sweet berry nose and soft, delicate tannin on the palate.
- 9. Waterstone Bridge “Shiraz” 2003 - Australia** **£13.50**
This Shiraz has been crafted from grapes from a blend of premium vineyards and has intense colour and boldly exhibits flavours of black cherry and peppery spice, blended in harmony to create an elegant, remarkably smooth wine.
- 10. Anakena Merlot Reserve, 2003 - Chile** **£14.95**
This Merlot is dark, ruby red in colour with strawberry and blackberry aromas. On the palate it is rich and smooth with rounded tannins and a very pleasant finish.
- 11. Pascual Toso “Malbec”, 2004 – Argentina** **£16.50**
This wine is smoky, with blackberry and liquorice fruit that keeps a firm grip through the finish. It is rich and long with smoky accents of vanilla and lingering oak.
- 12. Hope Estate “Shiraz” 2002 – Australia (Hunter Valley)** **£18.95**
Warming aromas of blackberry, mocha and cloves lead you to a palate of spicy plum and blackberry compote. An earthy finish with soft tannins gives this superb wine added depth and complexity.
- 13. Clairault “Cabernet Sauvignon” 2002 – Australia** **£20.95**
This Cabernet Sauvignon shows ripe cassis and blueberry characters with lifted notes of violets, cedery oak and a subtle earthiness. An elegant full bodied wine from western Australia’s Margaret River.
- 14. Pertaringa “Over the Top Shiraz” 2002 - Australia** **£27.95**
This classic Shiraz from McLaren Vale is deep cherry red in colour, exhibiting lovely menthol and spice aromas with ripe, spicy plum fruit and a hint of chocolate. An inviting palate with rich, ripe, dark fruit flavours and refreshing minty overtones.
